Wagner-Peyser Labor Exchange Program - Funds are being utilized to enhance job matching services at facilities throughout North Carolina. We have created 46 time-limited Employment Consultant positions to enhance our capabilities to deliver staff-assisted labor exchange services to employers and job seekers. These positions will enhance our capacity for helping employers find new workers and job seekers find new jobs.

Ex-Offender Services - We are utilizing a portion of this funding to implement a program which focuses on assisting ex-offenders in returning to the workforce. Funds have been utilized to create three Ex-Offender Coordinator positions which will be located in the western, central, and eastern regions of our State to assist local staff in implementing a program of intensive services to help ex-offenders return to gainful employment.

Reemployment Service Grant - Funding is being utilized to provide Reemployment Services at 79 local service facilities strategically located throughout North Carolina. Staff positions funded from these Recovery Act dollars will provide staff-assisted services to unemployed individuals who have been identified by a profiling model as having a high probability of exhaustion. The services provided are designed to either refer UI recipients to employment or to assist them in improving their job seeking skills to facilitate job searches which lead to reemployment. During this 15 month program, we are planning to serve approximately 40,000 UI recipients.

These staff members have been designated as "Job Coaches," who will oversee the Reemployment Services Program at locations across our State, and they will also provide direct services to program participants.</p> <p>To provide Wagner-Peyser labor exchange services to the universal population, we have created 46 time limited Employment Consultant positions. In addition, we have utilized a portion of this funding to establish an Employment Services Specialist position and two Employment Consultant II positions to coordinate services for the ex-offender population.</p>
