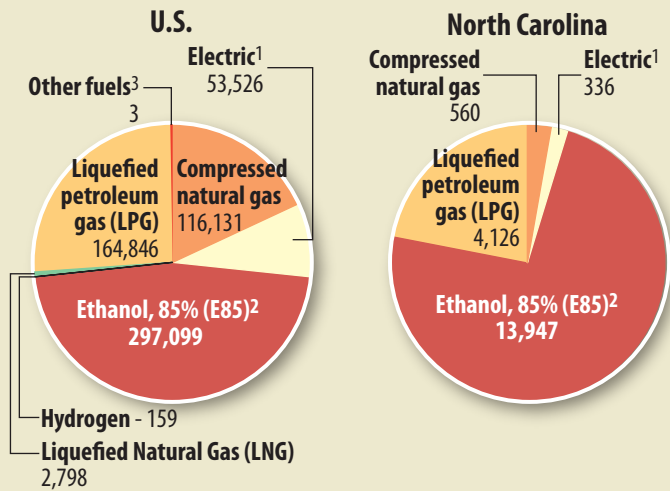


ALTERNATIVE FUELED VEHICLES

Some believe the U.S. can make up for declining oil production through alternative fueled vehicles. So far, they represent a fraction of the more than 250 million cars on the road.
